

40 DAYS OF PRAYER

1. Thank God for His salvation.

Psalms 103:1-12

My soul, bless the Lord, and all that is within me, bless his holy name. My soul, bless the Lord, and do not forget all his benefits. He forgives all your iniquity; he heals all your diseases. He redeems your life from the Pit; he crowns you with faithful love and compassion. He satisfies you with good things; your youth is renewed like the eagle. The Lord executes acts of righteousness and justice for all the oppressed. He revealed his ways to Moses, his deeds to the people of Israel. The Lord is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in faithful love. He will not always accuse us or be angry forever. He has not dealt with us as our sins deserve or repaid us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his faithful love toward those who fear him. As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.

2. Pray for unsaved people in your life by name. Pray that God would save them.

Romans 10:1

Brothers and sisters, my heart's desire and prayer to God concerning them is for their salvation.

3. Pray that God would help us be workers in the harvest.

- a. God would give us eyes that see.
- b. God would give us a heart that feels.
- c. God would give us hands that heal.
- d. God would give us a mouth that speaks.
- e. God would give us a mind that knows.
- f. God would give us knees that pray.

4. Pray that God would give us many opportunities to share the gospel and that we wouldn't be ashamed of the gospel.

Romans 1:16-17

For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, first to the Jew, and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith, just as it is written: The righteous will live by faith.

5. Pray that God would raise up workers in the harvest.

Matthew 9:35-38

Jesus continued going around to all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the good news of the kingdom, and healing every disease and every sickness. When he saw the crowds, he felt compassion for them, because they were distressed and dejected, like sheep without a shepherd. Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is abundant, but the workers are few. Therefore, pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into his harvest."

- a. Pray God would plant many churches out of Walnut Creek.
- b. Pray God would send out many missionaries to unreached peoples from WCC.
- c. Pray God would raise up many workers to reach Des Moines.
